The Shreeyash Pratisthan, Aurangabad has applied for establishment of Ayurved college at Shreeyash Ayurvedic College and Hospital Research Centre, Gut No. 258, Beed Bypass Road, New SRPF Camp, Satara Area, Aurangabad. On careful consideration of the proposal, the Government of Maharashtra has decided to issue "No Objection Certificate" to the applicant for the establishment of an Ayurved college with 100 seats.

It is certified that :-

- (a) The applicant owns & manages a 100 Bedded Hospital, which was established in the year 2018.
- (b) It is desirable to establish an Ayurved college in the public interest for starting BAMS course and
- (c) Establishment of Ayurved college at Shreeyash Ayurvedic College and Hospital Research Centre, Gut No. 258, Beed Bypass Road, New SRPF Camp, Satara Area, Aurangabad by Shreeyash Pratisthan, Aurangabad is feasible.

It is also certified that adequate clinical material as per norms of the Central Council of Indian Medicine is available with the proposed Ayurved College. It is further certified that in case the applicant fails to create infrastructure for the Ayurved college as per Central Council of Indian Medicine norms and fresh admissions are stopped by the Central Government, the State Government shall take over the responsibility of the students already admitted in the college with the permission of the Central Government.

This Certificate is Valid for a period of 3 years from the date of issue, thereafter it will automatically lapse.
